She regularly appears in the media, and has presented evidence on animal issues to local authorities, national governments, and CITES (Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species). In addition, her photographs and video of animals in circuses, laboratories and others, have been utilized in the media throughout the world.

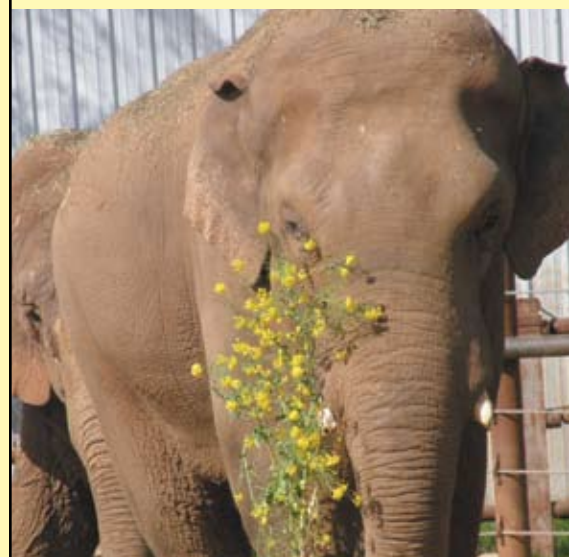

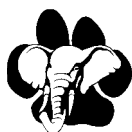
